Itinerary:

Day 01: London to Glasgow (approx. 3 hrs 30 mins)

Arrive Glasgow by train and embark on your scintillating road journey of Scottish Cliffs, Coasts and Castles. Pick your hired vehicle from City Centre and proceed to the Glasgow Hotel. Check in Hotel and rest of the day is free to explore the city. Overnight at hotel in Glasgow.



Day 02: Glasgow: Hop-on Hop-off Sightseeing

After breakfast, proceed on a Hop-on Hop-off sightseeing tour of Glasgow. Let this tour show you all the things to do in Glasgow, from excellent museums, art galleries and beautiful parks, there is something for all ages in this exciting Scottish city. In addition, the friendly pubs, welcoming cafes and bars,





and lively night clubs help to make Glasgow one of the new preferred destinations for short breaks for the younger and older generations. City Sightseeing's hop on hop off bus tours are the ultimate way to visit this vibrant city, which is packed with breathtaking sights and attractions. Overnight at hotel in Glasgow. (B)

Day 03: Glasgow – Fort William via Loch Lomond And Glencoe (Approx. 2 Hours 30 Minutes)

After breakfast, proceed towards Fort Williams en-route covering Loch Lomond and Glencoe. Travel through spectacular Glencoe, across wild Rannoch Moor and along the bonnie banks of Loch Lomond. Arrive Fort William and Overnight at hotel in Fort William. (B)



Day 04: Fort William: Visit Oban and Isle of Mull

After breakfast, explore the peaceful Ardnamurchan Peninsula, the most westerly point on mainland Britain with wonderful views to the small isles of Rum, Eigg & Muck. Relax on the white sandy beach at Ardtoe or travel on the magnificent Road to the Isles and then by ferry over the sea to the Isle of Skye. Experience the exceptional variety of wildlife on the West Coast of Scotland. See one of the classic malt whiskies's being made at Oban Distillery or visit 13th Century Dunstaffnage Castle, which overlooks the entrance to Loch Etive. Kilmartin Glen, the cradle of ancient Scotland and brooding Castle Stalker are short journeys from Oban. Scotland is home to some of the most beautiful island retreats in the world and a day trip to the Isle of Mull is a must. Famous for its stunning wildlife, you could get acquainted with whales, otters, puffins and basking sharks or enjoy a visit to Duart Castle - once home to the Chief of Clan MacLean. Tobermory is the island's main village with its multi-coloured houses scattered around the peaceful harbour. Nearby, the isle of Iona, known as 'The Cradle of Christianity', is a special place with impossibly turquoise waters, dazzling beaches and hidden coves. Overnight at hotel in Fort William. (B)





Day 05: Fort William – The Isle of Skye via Glenfinnan and Ferry (Driving Time from Fort)

William to Mallaig is approx. 1 hour, followed by a 30 minute ferry journey, and then an approx. 1 hour drive from Armadale to Portree)

After breakfast, proceed on the magnificent Road to the Isles and then by ferry over the sea to the Isle of Skye. The short sailing across the Sound of Sleat provides great views of Skye and back across to the west coast. Overnight at hotel in Isle of Skye. (B)



Day 06: Isle of Skye: Full Day Tour

After breakfast, proceed on a full day tour of Skye visiting the romantic Dunvegan Castle, sample some fine island whiskies, enjoy a great day's walking or take a fabulous cruise into the heart of the Cuillin Mountains. Overnight in at hotel Isle of Skye. (B)



Day 07: Isle of Skye – Gairloch (driving time approx 3hours)

After breakfast, proceed towards Gairloch. Discover the tranquil Applecross Peninsula and enjoy one of the most spectacular road trips in the British Isles; with breath-taking views of the Cuillin Mountains of Skye. Enjoy the splendour of Loch Maree before arriving in Gairloch on the west coast. Overnight at hotel in Gairloch. (B)



Day 08: Gairloch: Visit Ullapool & Wester Ross

After breakfast, visit famous Inverewe Gardens, on a promontory of Loch Ewe, walk along miles of deserted white beaches or enjoy some of the best walking in the ancient mountains of Torridon. Proceed further in the North of Scotland is Ullapool, a beautiful white-washed fishing village and the largest settlement in Wester Ross. More great beaches await you so take your time, relax and enjoy the solitude. Discover the magical Summer Isles, visit the far North-West Highlands and the grandeur and wilderness of the mountains of Assynt. Enjoy





an exhilarating walk to the summit of Stac Pollaidh for stunning views of the islands or a bracing cliff top walk to the Old Man of Storr. Overnight at hotel in Gairloch. (B)

Day 09: Gairloch – The Speyside/Cairngorms via Inverness (Driving Time Approx. 2 Hours 45 Minutes)

After breakfast, depart Gairloch & travel past the most famous of Scotland's castles, Eilean Donan. Your route takes you by the shores of brooding Loch Ness and Urquhart Castle and on to the Capital of the Highlands. Your destination is Speyside/Cairngorms - the heart of Scotland's Malt Whisky Industry. A full day to explore Speyside, one of the loveliest areas of Scotland, with its mountains, pristine pine forests and sparkling lochans. This is whisky country and a great opportunity to tour the whisky trail and visit some of the most famous whisky distilleries, including Glenfiddich, Glenlivet and the Macallan. You can also explore Inverness, visit 14th Century Cawdor Castle or tour the Culloden Battlefield and its state of the art Visitor Centre. Overnight at hotel in Speyside/Cairngorms. (B)



Day 10: Speyside/Cairngorms: Visit Moray Firth

After breakfast, proceeds for a full day visit the Moray Firth. The region of Moray, in the North East of Scotland, is famed for its malt whisky, breathtaking beaches like Burghead, Hopeman and Lossiemouth, and coastlines rich in birdlife, like Spey Bay and Culbin Sands. The Moray Firth is home to dolphins, whales and dramatic cliff-faces full of nesting seabirds, with rivers like the Spey and Findhorn providing fantastic salmon and trout-fishing spots. Moray, the birthplace of MacBeth, lies between the capital city of the Highlands, Inverness, and west of Aberdeenshire all the way south to Tomintoul, in the foothills of the Cairngorms National Park. Moray Firth is amongst the most beautiful and unspoilt coastline in Scotland; rich in wildlife, from nesting seabirds, to dolphins and whales. Overnight at hotel in Speyside/Cairngorms. (B)





Day 11: Cairngorms to Edinburgh via Highland Perthshire (driving time approx. 3 hours)

After breakfast, proceed from Cairngorms to Edinburgh via Highland Perthshire. Arrive in Edinburgh, Scotland's majestic Capital City. Edinburgh is a great place to wander - narrow alleys, flights of stairs and hidden courtyards tempt you off the main streets at every turn and for a spectacular view of the city take a walk up Arthur's Seat. Overnight at hotel in Edinburgh. (B)



Day 12: Edinburgh: Hop-On-Hop-Off City Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, proceed on a Hop-On-Hop-Off Edinburgh City Sightseeing Tour to really explore all Edinburgh has to offer. With great visitor attractions, museums, galleries and restaurants to suit every taste and budget Edinburgh's got it all! Capital of Scotland since the 15th Century, Edinburgh stands on seven hills creating the dramatic skyline of this lively cosmopolitan city. What better way to see this fantastic city than from the top of a City Sightseeing Tour Bus. Marvel at the impenetrable Castle Rock and hear about the attempts to capture Edinburgh Castle, see the Royal Mile which joins Edinburgh Castle to the Palace of Holyrood House and discover the fascinating history of this amazing city! Overnight at hotel in Edinburgh. (B)



Day 13: Edinburgh – London (train journey approx. 4 hrs 30 mins)

After breakfast, drop your hired vehicle in the city centre and proceed to the Edinburgh train station to board your train to London. (B)
