Itinerary:

Day 1: Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina)

Arrival to Sarajevo. In the late afternoon a sightseeing tour of this cosmopolitan European capital with a unique twist, the result of millennia exposed to various cultural and historical influences: a pure delight to visit. Walk around its historical and cultural center - Baščaršija - Sarajevo's old bazaar, designed according to the Arabian souk and the most famous meeting point for small talk and daily news over a traditional Turkish coffee. Dinner and overnight in Sarajevo. **Meals: Dinner**



Day 2: Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) – Mostar (Bosnia & Herzegovina) – Dubrovnik (Croatia)

Following breakfast, in the morning journey towards Mostar in its beautiful valley between the high mountains of Herzegovina, a picturesque old city recently added to the UNESCO World Heritage List. The city's famous, elegant and most recognizable





landmark is the Old Bridge made of stone, completely renewed after the war. It is a symbol of reconciliation and the coexistence of diverse cultural, ethnic and religious communities. In the late afternoon transfer to Dubrovnik. Dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik. **Meals: Dinner**

Day 3: Dubrovnik (Croatia)

Following breakfast, a sightseeing tour of this spectacular, UNESCO-protected, fortified city whose city walls can be walked on. Dubrovnik was known as the Republic of Ragusa in the Middle Ages and became the only Adriatic city-state to rival Venice. Supported by skilled diplomacy and wealth, the city achieved a remarkable development, particularly during the 15th and 16th century. In the afternoon, possibility for a cruise to Elafiti islands. Dinner and overnight in Dubrovnik. **Meals: Dinner**



Day 4: Dubrovnik (Croatia) – Budva (Montenegro) – Shkodra (Albania) – Tirana (Albania)

Following breakfast, transfer from Dubrovnik to Montenegro. Visit to Budva known for its Old City and surrounded by walls from the Venetian period. Then continue further on to Albania, crossing the border at Shkodra, once the capital of the Illyrian Kingdom (3rd century B.C.). Dinner and overnight in Tirana.

Meals: Dinner



Day 5: Tirana (Albania) – Ohrid (Macedonia)

Following breakfast, a sightseeing tour of Tirana, the capital of Albania, including Skender Bey Square, the Mosque of Ethem Bey, and the National Museum. Depart for Macedonia in the afternoon, via Elbasan and the Albanian-Macedonian border at Cafasan. Dinner and overnight in Ohrid. **Meals: Dinner**



Day 6: Ohrid (Macedonia) – Skopje (Macedonia)

Enjoy your morning at the lakeside resort of Ohrid, a UNESCO World Heritage listed site. Thanks to the work of St. Clement and St. Naum, the famous 'Ohrid Literary School' was founded here and thus the first pan-Slavic University in Europe. A sightseeing tour includes the Church of St. Sofia from the 11th century, with its magnificent Byzantine fresco paintings the pre-eminent mediaeval monument in Macedonia, and then St. Clement

Church with its icon of The Annunciation. In the early afternoon, visit to St. Naum Monastery, built on the shores of Lake Ohrid in 900 A.D. and dedicated to the Slavic missionary and educator St. Naum of Ohrid. Later in the afternoon transfer to Skopje. Dinner and overnight in Skopje. **Meals: Dinner**
